## Freelancing




#### The Status of Freelancing in Bangladesh:

This national Leader is also supports us to the path along developing our career as a freelancer. She assures all kinds of financial to transaction safety assurance from the government side.

According to the trade magazine Forbes, Bangladesh is among the top 10 countries in terms of income from freelancing. Bangladesh ranks eighth in freelancing income and Bangladesh's growth is 26 percent. Outsourcing has a market of one trillion US dollars a year in the world.

Bangladesh was on the second position in 2017 in online freelance workers' supply but now it is on the third position, says Oxford Internet Institute. Neighbouring India and Pakistan are respectively on the first and second position. As per a report of Payoneer, Bangladesh was in eighth position based on revenue growth in 2019. Unfortunately, in 2020 we could not even secure a place in the top ten list.



Although the income of this sector in Bangladesh is 1 billion, there is a possibility of 5 billion dollars. In the last few years, Bangladesh has made a lot of progress in freelancing, as a result of which the income of Bangladesh has reached 1 billion dollars, but Bangladesh has a huge opportunity in the freelancing sector. And if we want to do well in this sector, we have to increase the infrastructure and internet facilities.

Bangladesh is moving fast due to global digitization and technological development. Bangladesh is now becoming one of the most important countries in the world in digital outsourcing. According to the United Nations agency for trade and development's (UNCTAD) Digital Economy Report-2019, in Bangladesh there are about 6.5 million freelancers working in this sector and earning more than 100 million foreign exchange every year.

#### **Advantages:**

The rapid growth of digital technology has fundamentally changed the world as we know it. Bangladesh has experienced that change too. The rapid development of the online space in Bangladesh has been very exciting and promising.

Government initiatives to develop the ICT service sector, such as creating a high-tech park in every district, coupled with the low-cost workforce, have made Bangladesh a key player in the global outsourcing market.

Bangladesh has a huge presence of young people. Three out of four people in Bangladesh are below 40 years. The majority of youth population in Bangladesh can be a blessing for the country as young people have emerged as a major force behind economic development in many Asian countries.

Nevertheless, several challenges hinder the growth of this industry in Bangladesh. The absence of an uninterrupted power supply is still a major problem for the country. Freelancing work, like complex coding for software development, requires a high level of concentration, which is often shattered by the frequent power cuts.

A lack of quality internet services, along with higher broadband prices, is a major problem for freelancers in rural areas. In spite of having broadband connections in some areas, freelancers often find it too slow to suit their work.

The lack of an easy payment system — especially for receiving payments from foreign clients — is another problem for this fast-growing industry.

Right now freelancers are using Payoneer, Skill, Payza, Neteller, Zoom as online payment methods in Bangladesh. But in the developed world, PayPal is the most used for online money transactions. But PayPal service has not been launched in Bangladesh yet, so freelancers have to face various problems with the payment method to receive the money earned and pay in different cases, additional money is spent. However, the Bangladesh government and PayPal have discussed this and work is underway.

#### **Government Initiatives in the Freelancing Sector:**

After the announcement of Digital Bangladesh's' Roadmap 'in 2008, the government undertook three development programs -' My Village – My City, Good Governance and the Power of Youth'. The implementation of the digital revolution has become more 'dynamic'. According to this roadmap, the government has already taken various initiatives.

This includes government training opportunities. Initiatives have been taken to train 40,000 trainees across the country through the Learning and earning Project under the Ministry of ICT. In addition, the government has recently adopted a plan to recognize five lakh freelancers. Meanwhile, the ICT Department and the Bangladesh Freelancer Development Society have created a database of freelancers.

#### **Conclusion:**

Bangladesh can claim to be a key destination for global IT investment and outsourcing considering the huge presence of youth, a growing English-speaking population, and low costs. The outsourcing firms evaluate outsourcing destinations based on a number of factors specially the quality of services and the costing.

The government now focuses on turning unemployed young people into techsavvy workers and engages them in IT-based freelancing. In this way, the government of Bangladesh can attain its goal of translating the vision of Digital

Bangladesh into a reality by focusing on human capital development for the global digital economy.
