- Golden Age of Lyrics / Age of Revolution / Creative Period
- Theme/Slogan Art for Art's Sake
- Age of Lyrical Ballads
- This Age starts with the publication of Lyrical Ballads by Wordsworth and S.T.

Coleridge in 1798. Total 23 Poems - Wordsworth 19/ Coleridge - 4.

Most of the poets are influenced by The French Revolution

- Supernaturalism
